Swimming Lessons

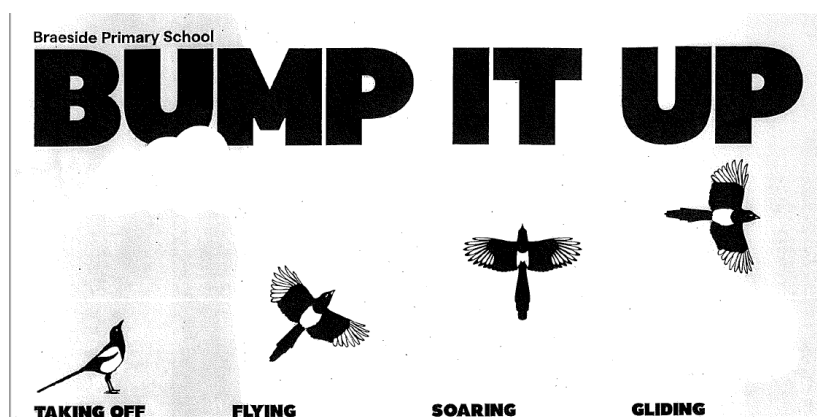

This will be used consistently across classes in 2022 and beyond, rather than teachers using different methods.
